

### AMERICANS UNACCOUNTED FOR IN SOUTHEAST ASIA

On 11/18/92, the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Special Office for Prisoners of War and Missing in Action, furnished the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Laboratory Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, an updated list of 2,264 Americans unaccounted for in the Southeast Asia conflict. To date, fingerprints of 836 persons who may or may not be the individuals on the updated list have been located in the FBI files. The service # and/or date of birth (DOB) furnished by DIA matches information contained in FBI files unless otherwise noted in parentheses.



### The Last Firebase Veterans Archive Project

The Last Firebase Veterans Archive Project is a not-for-profit veterans organization which was organized to fill the gap left as a result of the retirement of the POW/MIA advocacy group Homecoming II Project.

The Veterans Archive Project board of directors is made up of veterans and POW/MIA family members and it holds the largest database of POW/MIA information in the world outside of that on file within U.S. government agencies.

One of the first functions of The Veterans Archive Project was assuming responsibility, from the Homecoming II Project volunteers, for a veterans' demonstration site, now known as The Last Firebase which is located near the National Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.

Since Homecoming II Project raised the POW/MIA flag there in 1986, The Last Firebase has been occupied with its volunteers distributing diligently, nearly a million pages of literature a year concerning the plight of American POW/MIAs still not accounted for from the Vietnam War, and other veteran-related issues. The Veterans Archive Project, which adopted The Last Firebase as a part of its name, provides networking muscle and information fire power so desperately needed to keep its issues high profile and in front of the world...so America will "never" forget that all of our war veterans did not come home and that many of those who did, still need our support and help.

Operating day and night, 365 days a year, volunteers at The Last Firebase have distributed free, since its beginning, nearly 1.5 million copies of The U.S.

Veteran, a monthly veterans' advocacy newspaper. The U.S. Veteran is known internationally as a leader in the activist movement which is demanding a full accounting of U.S. POW/MIAs. This battle has been supported only by donations received for the printed material, such as POW/MIA bracelets, books, and t-shirts.

The Last Firebase took its name from a well-known fire support strategy developed by the U.S. military during the Vietnam War. Built on hilltops or areas of strategic importance, firebases were entrenchments on which heavy artillery was brought in and secured, providing 360 degree fire support for American and South Vietnamese forces operating beneath the surrounding, often raincloud-covered triple canopy jungle.

The firebase was a fortress of strength and, in many cases, the only available support for the ground forces whose objective was to search out and destroy Viet Cong guerillas and the North Vietnamese Army regulars who were using the thick, jungle terrain to their deadly advantage.

Today, The Last Firebase in Washington, similar to its Vietnam-era name-sake, manned with by Veterans Archive Project volunteers, provides strength and support for many POW/MIA family members who have repeatedly asked, to no avail, for help from U.S. government agencies in resolving the fate of their loved ones left behind in Southeast Asia.

## The goals of the Veterans Archive Project include:

- To collect, assemble, analyze and distribute printed and computerized/electronic information to increase public awareness that there are American servicemen still missing in action and evidence exists that some may still be alive in captivity.
- 2. To work with other individuals or groups whose goals coincide with those of The Last Firebase Veterans Archive Project, which are the return of live American POWs and the return of the remains of those who have perished.
- To encourage American citizens to use their influence with representatives of the U.S. government to augment efforts to achieve the return of American POW/MIAs.
  - 4. To limit its activities to only those which further its stated objectives.

## CATEGORIES OF DEGREES OF INFORMATION OF ENEMY KNOWLEDGE OF POW/MIA PERSONNEL

### CATEGORY 1 CONFIRMED KNOWLEDGE

This category includes all personnel who were:

- a. Identified by the enemy by name
- b. Identified by reliable information received from releases/escapees, or
- c. Reported by highly reliable intelligence sources.
- d. I.D. through analysis of all-source intelligence.

### CATEGORY 2 SUSPECT KNOWLEDGE

This category includes personnel who were:

- a. Involved in the same incidents as individuals reported in Category 1.
- **b.** Lost in areas or under such conditions that they may reasonably be expected to be known by the enemy
- ${f c.}$  Connected with an incident which was discussed but not identified by name in the enemy news media, or
- d. Probably identified through analysis of all-source intelligence.

### CATEGORY 3 DOUBTFUL KNOWLEDGE

This category includes personnel whose loss incident is such that it is doubtful that the enemy would have knowledge of the specific individuals (e.g., aircrews lost over water or remote areas).

### CATEGORY 4 UNKNOWN KNOWLEDGE

This category includes individuals:

- a. Whose time and place of incident are unknown (e.g., aircrew members downed at unknown locations or ground personnel separated from their unit at an unknown time or place), and
- b. Who do not meet the criteria of category 1 through 3.

### **CATEGORY 5**

This category includes U.S. personnel whose remains have been declared non-recoverable.
