- * Name
- * Age (date of birth)
- * Dates of service
- * Source of commission
- * Rank/grade and date attained
- * Marital status
- * Promotion sequence number
- * City/town and state of last known address and date of this address
- * Serial/service number (those issued prior to the use of the social security number as the service number)
- * Decorations and awards
- * Place of birth; date and geographical location of death; and place of burial+
- * Military and civilian education level
- * Photograph (or photocopy if only one photo is available)
- * Place of induction and separation
- * Duty assignments (including geographical location)
- * Dependents (including name, sex, and age)
- * records of court-martial trial (unless classified)
- * education/schooling (military)

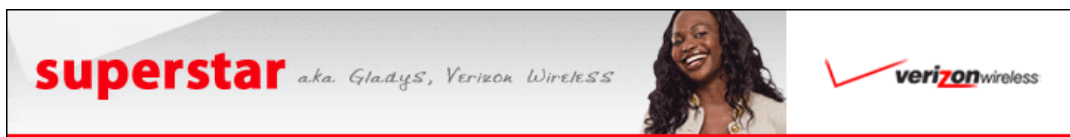
